# Introduction

- While peace is something we all desire in the details of this life, there is a far greater peace with greater implications.
- And that is peace with God and from God.
- One of the fruit of the spirit peace (Gal. 5:22)

# The Peace Of God

- What is peace?
- From the Greek word--εἰρήνη (eirene) –
- To be in a state of tranquility or calmness.
- Harmony and concord.

“Imagine there's no countries  
It isn't hard to do  
Nothing to kill or die for  
And no religion too  
Imagine all the people  
Living life in peace

# The Peace Of God

- The source of this peace – God – “God of peace” –
- [Romans 15:33](#), “Now the God of peace ...”
- [Romans 16:20](#), “And the God of peace ...”
- [Philippians 4:9](#), The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace...”
- [1 Thessalonians 5:23](#), “Now may the God of peace”
- As we can see there are many passages that directly address God as the God of peace.

# The Peace Of God

- [Phil. 4:6-7](#), “*Be anxious for nothing...*” This peace “surpasses all understanding.”
- This means that it is something difficult to describe – especially to one in the world who doesn’t understand it and doesn’t want to either.

# The Peace Of God

- The reason it is difficult to understand is because it comes from God.
- Jesus told His disciples, *“Peace I leave with you...”*  
([John 14:27](#))
- It rules in our hearts - [Colossians 3:15](#), *“And let the peace of God...”*

# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- By purifying your hearts and minds –
- This involves both God's part (being made right with Him – obeying the gospel) and us putting forth the necessary efforts to cleanse ourselves.
- [Romans 8:6](#) says, *“For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.”*
- [Colossians 3:15](#) speaks of the peace of God ruling in our hearts.
- WE must strive to live pure lives if we want peace.
- Living with impurities will bring misery, fear, guilt and other qualities that rob us of our peace.



# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- By seeking it – [1 Peter 3:10-12](#), *“For “He who would love life And see good days, Let him refrain his tongue from evil, ...*A quotation from [Psalm 34:12-16](#)
- Peace is something we ought to crave.

# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- By learning to trust in God –
- that is what faith is about.
- Proverbs 3:5–6, *“Trust in the Lord ...”*
- Isaiah 26:3. In a passage addressing Judah (and actually looking toward the Messiah and His kingdom) he says of God, *““You will keep him in perfect peace...”*

# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- By not worrying –
- [Matthew 6:25-34](#) finds Jesus speaking about not worrying.
- How many fail to find peace because they worry too much about everything?
- NOTE that this does not mean we never show concern –
- it deals with anxiety –
- an obsession with worry.

# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- Through self-acceptance –
- to be at peace with yourself, you have to accept who you are.
- In this I do NOT mean that you accept ungodly behavior in your life!
- You have to take care of your sins.
- I mean you need to accept your place in life and if you are striving to do your best, accept yourself.
- Don't be your own worst enemy!

# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- By being content –
- [Philippians 4:11-13](#) – *Not that I speak in regard to need..*
- Be content in whatever state you find yourself in.

# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- Through keeping His word –
- [Ephesians 6:15](#) - in describing our spiritual armor, Paul noted that our feet are to be shod with “the gospel of peace.”
- [Psalm 119:165](#), “*Great peace have those ...*”
- [Philippians 4:8-9](#), “*Finally, brethren...*”

# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- Through prayer –
- Again [Philippians 4:6-7](#). When we are anxious, we need to learn to pray and cast our cares on Him.
- He does care ([1 Peter 5:6-7](#)).
- [James 5:16](#) tells us that **the effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man accomplishes much.**
- And don't forget to pray for others – [1 Timothy 2:1-2](#) tells us to pray for kings that we may be able to lead a quiet and peaceable life.

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# How To Obtain The Peace Of God

- Live in peace –
- Again [Matthew 5:9](#), “Blessed are the peacemakers.”
- [2 Corinthians 13:11](#), “*Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete...*”
- [Heb. 12:14](#), “*Pursue peace...*”

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
