SONG IMPACT ON THE BRAIN

- **Measured brain activity when listening to music and the blood flow to different parts of the brain**
- **Found that the part of the brain that focuses on thought, empathy and self-awareness was triggered when listening. Listeners' did not prefer a type of music/genre.**
- **Songs with greatest impact on listener altered connectivity between brain areas responsible for memory and social emotion.**
- **“Experience with music is the most important to how you feel.”**
