The Contrast is one of Pure Religion

- We must examine ourselves.
 (2 Cor. 13:5)
- We must let God examine us. (1 Cor. 4:5)
- We must not think too highly of ourselves. (Rom. 12:3)

God has always cared for the orphans and widows.

- (Isa. 58:3, 10-11) Give yourselves to yourselves to the hungry.
- · (Lev. 19:18) Love you neighbor...
- (Ps. 68:5,6) A father of the fatherless
- (Ex. 22:22-24) Do not afflict a widow or orphan.
- (Dt. 10:17,18; 14:28,29) Eat and be satisfied.

 - -True Love (1 John 3:17-19)
