- New generations had served other deities and forgotten God.
- Judges 18:30 Moses grandson

# The Value of Conviction with regard to Souls.

- Each generation had those willing to stand for what is right.
- Judges 5:15; 23-27 Deborah
- Judges 7:7, 12, 19ff Gideon
- Judges 16:31 Samson

# **God was proving Israel, just as He proves us today.**

- Physical blessings (Dt. 8:2-4)
- Physical hardships (Dt. 8:15-17)
- False prophets (Dt. 13:1-4)
- Ungodly influences (Judges 3:1-4)

# **God does not tolerate intentional sin in His people.**

- In those days... did what was right in their own eyes

(Jdgs. 17:6, 18:1; 19:1 and 21:25)

# **We are forced to deal with the question of why man sins.**

- Why have you done this (Jdgs. 2:2)
- Lacking in Israel (Jdgs. 21:3)

# **We learn of God's Mercy.**

- Israel commmits idolatry (Jdgs. 3:7; 10:6)
- Too many people believe their sins are too great (Jn. 8:1-11; 1 Jn 1:9)
