Trusting God to Increase

Planting spiritual seeds is a recurring biblical theme, reminding us that while we may sow and nurture, only God brings true growth. Paul writes, "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase." (1 Corinthians 3:6)

Planting begins with sharing faith and acts of love, as Jesus taught in the Parable of the Sower (Matthew 13:3-9). Watering follows through prayer, teaching, and encouragement, echoing the call to nurture one another (Hebrews 10:24-25). Yet, Scripture teaches it is God who produces the increase (1 Corinthians 3:7).

We are called to be faithful in sowing and watering, but to trust God for the results, as Paul reminds us: "So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase." (1 Corinthians 3:7). Spiritual growth unfolds in His timing; we should not grow weary in doing the work. (Galatians 6:9).

Let us sow seeds of faith (2 Corinthians 9:6) and rely on God to provide the increase and give the harvest (Matthew 9:37-38). Be a laborer in His vineyard.




