Look for the Helpers

Fred Rogers often repeated a simple but profound piece of wisdom from his mother: *“When you see scary things in the world, look for the helpers. You will always find people who are helping.”* It’s a reminder that even in moments of fear, confusion, or loss, goodness has not disappeared. It may be quiet, but it is present — often in the hands and hearts of ordinary people doing extraordinary acts of kindness.

Scripture takes that same truth and anchors it even deeper. Hebrews 13:5 contains God’s promise: *“I will never leave you nor forsake you.”* If Mr. Rogers taught us to look for the helpers, the Hebrew writer teaches us to look beyond the helpers to the One who empowers them. God’s presence is not occasional or conditional. It is constant, steady, and faithful.

When life feels overwhelming, helpers remind us that compassion still lives in the world. But God’s promise reminds us that we are never facing those moments alone. He is the ultimate Helper — the One who moves people to act, who strengthens weary hearts, and who walks with us through every valley.

So when the world feels heavy, look for the helpers. Thank God for them. And then rest in the greater truth: the Lord Himself is with you, unshakable and unchanging, the Helper who never leaves.

There will be times that you need to be the helper, so don’t forget that your light can shine as well. God’s light shines brightest in the darkest times.
